Getting Started:

Your journey into dog training should begin with a solid understanding of why your dog does what she does along with setting some realistic goals within the framework of *your* family. A **Behavior Evaluation & Consultation** will set the foundation for your individually tailored training plan. This initial session takes place in your home or neutral location based on your dog's previously determined particular needs. Evaluation Fee: \$125 (approx 60 minutes)

Private Instruction:

Whether you are in need of basic training or complex behavior modification, the 1x1 attention you receive in a **Private Lesson** will ensure that you and your dog have developed the "mental toolbox" needed to set the two of you up for success in a group and/or real-life setting. A series of three private lessons is typically recommended for dogs experiencing moderate to severe behavior problems including - but not limited to - aggression, anxiety, and/or separation issues. Your learnings will arm you with a proactive and productive style of communicating with your pet in a way that he/she actually understands! Private Lesson Fee: \$125/session (approx 60 minutes) or purchase 3 sessions in advance at \$300.

Educational Lectures, Workshops, Classes & Seminars:

A variety of learning opportunities covering a wide range of topics and needs are all aimed at getting you and your dog thinking and working as a team. Program topics include, but are not limited to:

New Dog Ownership, Relationship Repair, Dogs & Babies Family Learning, Setting the Foundation for Leash-walking or Recall, Puppy and/or Adult Basics, Canine Good Citizens, Rally Obedience, Agility, Rescue Work/Foster Programs and more!

Outdoor Adventures:

A rather popular program designed to aid you in achieving your individual training goals even while you are away at work! This **In-Home Day Training Program** gets your dog outdoors for a 1x1 training session to build new skills or solidify and cement previously learned behavior. The visit will last approximately 30 minutes and will start with a nice long walk to potty and relax. A series of short, but intense training, socialization and/or play sessions will follow. Ultimately, the program serves to give dogs a positive way to channel their energy so owners may enjoy a happy, balanced and relaxed dog upon their return from work. The Outdoor Adventure Program benefits all dogs, but is particularly useful for the special-needs or difficult dog that still needs some structured work throughout the day.
